

Year-End Points Rules

Points will be awarded to the tractor, regardless of the driver.

Points will be calculated for the following classes: Div 1 (Farm Stock) 4 MPH, Div 2 Uncut 4 MPH, Div 2 Cut 6 MPH, Div 3 Uncut 4 MPH, Div 3 Cut 6 MPH, Div 4 Cut 8 MPH, and Altered Stock 10 MPH. Weight classes as listed on the flyer, including 3750, 4000, 4250, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6000 and 6500. Div 1 Farm Stock 4 MPH will also have 10000. Please refer to the Pull Series flyer for complete class listing.

Points Fee will be required for each weight class per tractor.

DQ will earn no place points, only hook points.

For points to be awarded, the fee must be paid prior to the class start.

Points will be awarded as follows:

1. Hook points - Tractor will receive 20 points for making a pull of a measurable distance.
2. Placing points - Tractor will receive points according to their finishing position as follows:
 - 1st - 20 points
 - 2nd - 18 points
 - 3rd - 16 points
 - 4th - 14 points
 - 5th - 12 points

Tractors finishing 6th place and back will receive 10 points

Points placing for classes will be independent of class placing. For example, if the tractors who placed first and second were not entered into the Points Payback, the tractor placing third in the class would earn first place in points but still be placed third in the class.

In the event of a rain out or cancellation, no points will be awarded. A pull will be considered a rain out if it is canceled prior to or during the event (if all tractors in the class are not allowed to pull due to weather or sled breakage.)

If the registered owner of the tractor cannot attend a pull, a substitute driver may pull the tractor in the owner's place to compete for points. The driver must specify this at registration.

In the event of a tie, the win will be awarded to the driver/tractor with the most 1st place finishes. If still tied, then the most 2nd, 3rd, etc. If still tied, the total distances pulled for the year will be added up.

Points Fee:

\$50 per tractor per weight class to be included in the Points Payback.

Example: If the tractor is entered in the 4500, 5000 and 5500 classes, \$150 fee will be due.

If only in the 4500 class, \$50 will be due. This is a one-time per season fee.

A tractor can compete for points in up to 4 classes. If a driver has multiple tractors in the same weight classes and wants to be in the Points Payback with each tractor, the points fee will apply to each tractor.

A driver can enter into the Points Payback at any time during the season. However, points will not start accumulating until the points fee is paid for that class(s).

This fee is separate from the entry fee. The points fee is not required for entry into classes if the driver is not interested in the Year-End Points Payback.
