The club participates in community outreach and provides scholarship opportunities for students pursuing education and careers in agricultural and related fields.

The club is pleased to offer the Grass Roots College Scholarship in the amount of \$500 to a high school senior, or a student currently enrolled in college as a freshman, sophomore, or junior.

Scholarship Criteria

- Must be a resident of Illinois, or be a member or immediate family of a Grass Roots Tractor Club member
- Have a 2.5 GPA or better (4.0 scale)
- Plan or currently attend a two/four-year college/university
- Pursue a major in agriculture, food services or natural resources
- Be a current or former member of FFA or 4H
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a non-family member, employer or teacher
- Anyone who has applied for the scholarship is eligible to reapply but must submit a new application.

Interested applicants must submit the following

- Completed application (please type responses)
- Copy of high school transcript. If currently in college, applicant must include copy of college transcript
- Letter of recommendation
- Applications must be postmarked by March 15, 2024 and mailed or emailed to:

3. Any necessary information such as student ID number, etc. for the scholarship to be credited to their student account.
