The club participates in community outreach and provides scholarship opportunities for students pursuing education and careers in agricultural and related fields or a skilled trade.

The club is pleased to offer the Grass Roots Technical Scholarship in the amount of \$500 to a high school senior, or a student currently enrolled in a technical/vocational school program.

Scholarship Criteria

- Must be a resident of Illinois, or be a member or immediate family of a Grass Roots Tractor Club member
- Preference will be given to high school seniors and students aged 18-24.
- Plan or currently attend a vocational or technical school
- Pursue an associate degree, certificate or diploma in a vocational, technical or skilled trade
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a non-family member, employer or teacher
- Anyone who has applied for the scholarship is eligible to reapply but must submit a new application

Interested applicants must submit the following

- Completed application (please type responses)
- Copy of high school transcript. If currently in technical school, applicant must include copy of technical school transcript
- Letter of recommendation
- Applications must be postmarked by March 15, 2025 and mailed or emailed to:

- 1. Proof of enrollment at the technical or vocational school they are attending.

- 3. Any necessary information such as student ID number, etc. for the scholarship to be credited to their student account.
