The club participates in community outreach and provides scholarship opportunities for students pursuing education and careers in agricultural and related fields or a skilled trade.

The club is pleased to offer the Grass Roots Workforce Assistance in the amount of \$250 to a young adult or high school senior entering the workforce upon graduation. The purpose of this assistance is to assist students entering the workforce who are required to provide their own tools, personal protective gear, clothing, work-specific footwear such as steel-toed boots, fire retardant apparel, etc.

Assistance Criteria

- Must be a resident of Illinois, or be a member or immediate family of a Grass Roots Tractor Club member
- Preference will be given to high school seniors and applicants aged 18-24.
- Currently employed or have a start date of employment.
- Must have a letter from the current or future employer stating the job functions and requirements of the employee
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a non-family member, employer or teacher
